The event will include a cultural performance by 135 performers from China's nine provinces. Highlights include traditional Chinese dances and music, martial arts, acrobatic performances and a Chinese opera puppet show. Following the opening remarks and performance, HRH Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will visit a handful of food stalls at the **Yaowarat Street Food Fair**, including the Red Rose Restaurant booth (see below).


Road Closure on Yaowarat Road
